“Cyber Attacks on Executive Teams”

Dr. Chris Pierson, Founder/CEO, Blackcloak

Biography

Dr. Chris Pierson is the Founder & CEO of BLACKCLOAK - a concierge cybersecurity protection suite for high-net-worth individuals and top C-Suite executives. BLACKCLOAK protects its customers from financial loss, cybercrime, hacking, reputational damage, privacy exposure, and identity theft. Dr. Pierson serves on the Department of Homeland Security’s Data Privacy & Integrity Advisory Committee, DHS Cybersecurity Subcommittee, and is a Distinguished Fellow of the Ponemon Institute.

Chris has been on the front lines of cybersecurity and fighting cybercrime and has over 20 years - with DHS, President of the Federal Bureau of Investigation’s Arizona InfraGard, and in various other roles as a Chief Information Security Officer for financial companies. Chris was a founding executive of Viewpost, a FinTech payments company, serving as their CISO and General Counsel and was also the first Chief Privacy Officer, SVP for the Royal Bank of Scotland’s (RBS) U.S. operations leading its privacy and data protection program. Chris was also a corporate attorney for Lewis & Roca where he established its CyberSecurity Practice representing companies who were hacked and had data breaches.

Chris is a globally recognized keynote speaker & cybersecurity thought leader.

Summary

Cybercriminals have migrated their attacks from larger businesses and hardened targets to those where the defenses are low or nonexistent - C-Suite executives in their personal lives. Hackers always follow the path of least resistance and that means attacking your personal email, devices, homes, and your family. But there are things you can do to fight back and protect your finances, reputation, personal data and ultimately your company.

Today we’ll hear from Dr. Chris Pierson, CEO of BLACKCLOAK, a Concierge Cybersecurity firm that represents private wealth/high-profile persons and C-Suite executives in their digital lives. For over 20 years, Ilene Klein has been evangelizing security to anybody who would listen ... and to management. During this time, she built and led compliance, governance, incident response, privacy, policy, security awareness, threat intelligence, and vulnerability management programs and frameworks. Ilene started her career as an electronics instructor and then traveled from Honolulu to Heidelberg as a systems engineer installing proprietary software for the U.S. Army and resolving system crashes before focusing on cybersecurity. Ilene has earned multiple security and privacy certifications, and she’s won awards such as the CISM Geographic Excellence Award for earning the highest score in the North America geographical region on the December 2011 CISM examination and a 2018 Warrior Award for fighting on the “front lines” of cybersecurity.
